#### **EDUCATION**

 Child Care Assistance Program (Maintain current funding levels for CCAP Statewide/Creation of a Task Force Statewide)

#### FINANCIAL SECURITY

- Earned Income Tax Credit (Support continued funding for EITC)
- Minimum Wage (Pre-emption bill or raise the Minimum Wage Legislation sponsor/Sen. Troy Carter)
- Pay Secrecy (Preserve Equal Pay for Women's Act that is currently on the books 23.661 –
   669 Legislation sponsor/Rep. Patrick Connick)
- Predatory Lending (Monitor legislation that may hinder positions we have taken in the past that will further negatively impact our ALICE community)

#### **HEALTH**

- Domestic Violence (Legislation sponsors include, but are not limited to: Rep. Helena Moreno, Sen. JP Morrell, Sen. Danny Martiny, Rep. Julie Stokes and Rep. Malinda White)
  - Prohibited Possessor Firearm Relinquishment
  - Lie and Try Background Check Enforcement and Notification
  - Crimes of Violence
- Sexual Harassment in the Workplace
- Human Trafficking (Continue to monitor anything that comes under this issue)
- Medicaid Work Requirements (Monitor legislation in collaboration with our partners including LBP, 504 HealthNet and Governor's Office)
