A Washington Parish Success Story

Washington Parish's cancer survivorship program, led by the Cancer Association of Greater New Orleans with funding from United Way, started as an educational support group to improve the lives of local cancer patients and has blossomed into a parishwide beautification project. Today, We CAN-CERVive's members are organizing two community fundraising events and planning gardening and tree planting projects at the Franklinton, Enon, and Bogalusa libraries.

Even in the face of COVID-19, the group continued to flourish. Without access to high-speed internet in the parish, the members found an online meeting platform to allow them to continue supporting each other along their cancer journeys.
