3. Applications are open to the public. Any Women United member and/or pre-determined agency staff member is able to advocate for a proposal during a finite time period provided during a Women United General meeting. After discussion occurs, anyone associated with the agency (including staff, board members and/or sponsors of proposal) will be asked to leave the room and recuse themselves from voting.
