

# The NOLA Coalition

In July 2022, the NOLA Coalition – a broad group of over 400 nonprofits, civic organizations, and businesses, including UWSELA and the CYPB – announced a two-part, concurrent strategy to address crime and quality of life in New Orleans. The Investment in Youth Support Service pillar seeks to implement the YMP and raise \$15M from new funding sources over the next three years (\$5M per year) to be distributed across eligible youth-serving organizations through three competitive grant cycles.

To date, the coalition has raised \$756,300 in general funds for the first grant cycle and an additional \$1.5M in designated funds.
