By dialing 211 or texting 898211, you are connected with a trained specialist who will help you identify what resources are available to address your need.

IRS-certified volunteers provide free basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing to qualified individuals.

PROSPERITY CENTERS located in Covington and New Orleans - our one-stop financial stability centers offering an array of programming to residents in Jefferson, Orleans, Plaguemines, St. Bernard, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, and Washington parishes, including financial education and coaching, credit building and counseling, benefits screening, and income tax assistance.

Our IDA (Individual Development Account) program is designed to help low-income participants save money through a matched-savings program.

MYFREETAXES.COM Provides free state and federal tax preparation and filing assistance for qualified individuals. It's easy, safe, secure and 100% FREE.

SINGLECARE The pharmacy discount card is FREE for everyone. Whether or not you have health insurance coverage, you are eligible to begin saving on your prescription medications today.
